Having your vaccine at Shenstone House Surgery

Please read the following information before your COVID-19 vaccination appointment, remember to wear a face covering (unless you are exempt from wearing one), sanitise your hands on arrival and when leaving, and keep your distance ideally two metres apart where possible.

When you arrive at the surgery the door will be wedged open.

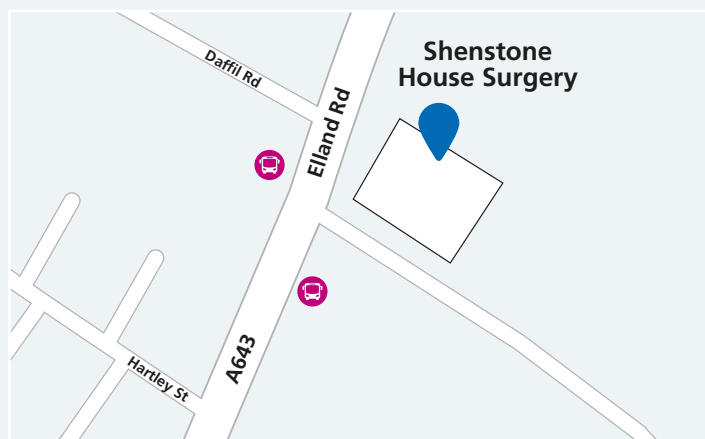
Bringing someone with you to your appointment
